**Water-Wise Habits  
for the Holidays**

As families and friends gather around the table to enjoy the upcoming holidays, we want to encourage our customers and communities to practice easy-to-follow water-wise habits.

1. Fill up the sink to wash dishes.
2. Thaw frozen foods ahead of time in the refrigerator instead of water.
3. Only wash full loads when using a dish washer.
4. Scrape leftovers into compost bin rather than rinsing them off the plate.
5. Collect water used to rinse fruits and veggies and use them to water plants and holiday trees.
6. Consider installing low-flow devices, such as aerators and shower heads to save water before guests arrive.
